Mini Soccer Rules

5 & 6 year olds

- 1. Size # 3 soccer balls will be used.
- 2. Maximum of 7 players on the field at any time during the game. (6 outfield players plus a goalkeeper).
- 3. One coach of each team will be allowed on the field of play. (But never within the goal area).
- 4. Game to be divided into 2 halves of 20 minutes each, with a five minute break at half.
- 5. The referee has to explain infractions to the offending players.
- 6. Throw-ins, same player will continue throw-in until successful.
- 7. On throw-ins, corner kicks, and goal kicks, the opposing team has to yield 5 yards. (ie the opposing players have to be at least 5 yards from the ball).
- 8. Unlimited substitution during any stoppage of play with permission of referee.
- 9. Players cannot at any time enter the semi-circle of an opposing team. To score a goal the ball has to be kicked from outside the goal box.
- 10. On a goal-kick, only the goalkeeper can restart the play with a goal-kick from within the goal box.
- 11. The goalkeeper cannot handle the ball outside the goal box.
- 12. NO DIRECT FREE KICKS.
- 13. NO PENALTY KICKS.
- 14. NO OFF-SIDE RULE. (Advise coaches to avoid taking advantage of this rule).
- 15. Two goal rule. A player may only score up to a maximum of agoals in any one game, after that point the goals will not be counted.
- 16. The referees (Certified or In-House) have total control of the game and can stop a game at any time for whatever reason. Some of these reasons may be a coach or parent acting out of line, weather conditions, parents or coaches failing to observe FIFA rules or Club rules.
- 17. During a game, no assistant coach or parent helper is allowed on the opposite side of the field, behind or along side of any goal, or near the goal line for any reason.
- 18. FIFA rules to be used, except for the modification as stated above.
- 19. Any issues with parents or coaches must be discussed with the referee convenor immediately after the game.
